Koalas are particular about what type of gum leaves they eat. There are approx. 900 species of eucalypt in Australia and koalas will eat about 40 to 50 of those types depending on where they live. But then of the 40 to 50 trees, there is about 10 they prefer to eat most of the time. Koalas can eat up to 2.2 lbs or 1 kg of leaves a day.
