How to Assess Higher-Order Thinking Skills in Your ...

Assessing higher-order thinking almost always involves three additional principles: Present something for students to think about, usually in the form of introductory text, visuals, scenarios, resource... Use novel material—material that is new to the student, not covered in class and thus subject ...

General Principles for Assessing Higher-Order Thinking

The scoring is part of the assessment: if a question requires higher-order thinking but the scoring scheme only gives points for correct recall of facts, the assessment fails as a measure of higher-order thinking. Of course, assessment of higher-order thinking assumes teaching of higher-order thinking. Although teaching these skills is not the subject of this book, it is worth noting that working through tasks like those in this book, with lots of feedback, could be part of such instruction.
