Health outcome measures come in many shapes and sizes and how they are defined depends on the domain being measured and the values and interests of the governing agency. For example: The International Consortium for Health Outcomes Measurement (ICHOM) defines health outcomes as “the results that matter most to patients” rather than those that matter most to physicians and healthcare organizations.

### The Who, What, and How of Health Outcome Measures

Health outcomes measures for nutrition 1-5. The effectiveness of nutrition programs depends on the intensity of program effort and the use of multiple interventions. A rule of thumb is that the more programs implemented together as a package or campaign, the more successful the interventions will be. Baseline

### Measures for Evaluating Health Promotion and Disease ...

Appropriate measures demonstrate changes in health conditions, quality of life, and behaviors. Impact evaluation: Impact evaluation assesses a program's effect on participants. Appropriate measures include changes in awareness, knowledge, attitudes, behaviors, and/or skills.

### Types of Evaluation in Health Promotion and Disease ...

Outcome measures assess the results of health care that are experienced by patients. The data for the Home Health outcome measures are derived from 2 sources: (1) data collected in the Outcome and Assessment Information Set (OASIS) submitted by home health agencies; and (2) data submitted in Medicare claims.

The amount of elapsed time used to measure progress also may have undercut the potential for community health outcomes, the research team pointed out. “Improving population-level health outcomes is difficult, and it takes time to ‘move the needle’ on health outcomes,” the researchers wrote.

### Assessing the Outcomes, Successes of Community Health Programs

Process measures can inform consumers about medical care they may expect to receive for a given condition or disease, and can contribute toward improving health outcomes. The majority of health care quality measures used for public reporting are process measures. Outcome Measures. Outcome measures reflect the impact of the health care service or intervention on the health status of patients. For example: The percentage of patients who died as a result of surgery (surgical mortality rates).

### Types of Health Care Quality Measures | Agency for Health ...

Health Outcomes Measures. Employees who adopt healthy behaviors not only reduce their risk for developing disabling or life threatening diseases and their associated costs, but improve their everyday quality of life. Participation in health promotion activities through a workplace health program allows individuals to develop knowledge, self-management and coping skills as well as build a social support network among coworkers, supervisors, and family.

CMS has since expanded the publicly reported outcome measures to include 30-day readmission complications, and excess days in acute care (EDAC) measures as well as in-hospital adverse events and mortality.

Other outcome measures In addition to PHQ-8 depression, six outcomes were measured in both studies. These consisted of three health indicators (pain, fatigue, and social role/activity limitation), one behavior (medication adherence), and two utilization (emergency department visits and hospitalizations) variables.
